

EBAH Terms & Conditions for Account Holders

European Board for Accreditation in Hematology (EBAH) offers professionals active in the field of hematology an online platform on which they can register as account holders and manage the history of their EBAH-accredited event. This service is offered free of cost.

In order to work according to and maintain the highest possible quality standards, EBAH has adopted two sets of rules & regulations:

- The EBAH Standards and Guidelines for Activity Accreditation stipulate the functionality and requirements for events accreditation.
- The EBAH Standards and Guidelines for Provide Accreditation stipulate the functionality and requirements for accreditation of CME providers.

In order to create an account within the EBAH system, the following terms and conditions are applicable:

i. Users are eligible to open the EBAH account based on the information that they provide themselves, EBAH Office does not verify this information, e.g., about education, training, experience, and credentials.

ii. EBAH account holders are themselves responsible for correctly completing their personal information. All information provided must be based on real, factual data. It is not allowed to feign data or to use aliases or any other pseudo information.

iii. Application to create the EBAH account is voluntary, by creating an account new account holders confirm information with respect to their professional status and confirm to meet requested requirements.

iv. EBAH account holders remain at all times completely and solely responsible for their actions and for all professional (medical) services they provide.

v. EBAH Office does not in any way, implicitly or explicitly, determine, guarantee, or warrant the professional standing, competencies, services, or actions of any of its account holders.

vi. Having the EBAH account is not in any way intended to be, nor should it be construed as being, a substitute for any professional and/or legal requirements for practicing in any field of medicine in general or the field of hematology in particular.

vii. The EBAH Office does not in any way provide testimonials, recommendations, or any other personal information about its account holders to other persons, National Hematology Associations, or any other organization.

viii. None of the provided information and contact details of account holders will be used for any commercial advertising or promotion.

viii. EBAH is an independent and autonomous operating unit. The online services offered are supported and maintained by the Executive Office of the European Hematology Association.
